### **Upper Hutt Branch 63 NZART: 60 Years**

Below is a copy of some notes as President I intended to say on the night, but the noise at the restaurant on the night precluded any speeches so here are my intended words:

A brief history of Branch 63:

The inaugural meeting was held on Tuesday 3 December 1946 at the residence of Brian Anderson ZL2CS, 187 Main Road Upper Hutt. It was attended by ZL2DU Jack Lynch (who was elected Chairman), ZL2JZ Allan Dawson, ZL2FV Jack McCann, ZL2VP Arthur Cheshire, ZL2CS Brian Anderson, Messrs A. Donnell, Brian Harris, A. Holland and Howard Scott. Apologies were received from Athol Neighbours and Doug Mudgeway (later ZL2LT). Allan Dawson ZL2JZ and Arthur Cheshire offered to coach classes. The Break-In scribe was Brian Anderson ZL2CS.

An annual club levy of five shillings per member was agreed, plus sixpence each per meeting night to cover supper.

ZL2VH was first issued to Eric J. Jacobson in 1937. January 1948 to 1964 callbooks show ZL2VH allocated to B.O.V. Hoskin, 4 Emerson Street, Petone. In February 1966, Break-In shows ZL2VH allocated to Upper Hutt Branch with W.G. Fisher (ZL2AYB) as Trustee.

The club now proudly recognises hits heritage in the call —ZL2VH. (Continued on page 3)
