"The section "...The IARU contribution to the Guidance recommendation proposed specific limits for EME operation in the range 1296 – 1300 MHz.

The proposal was largely adopted but only in the range 1298 – 1300MHz..." sounds both good and bad.

Maybe good because moving operation closer to the band edge might be something that would be considered as a move to minimize interference and thus be acceptable to the those concerned about these things. Bad in that anyone using a 28-30 or 144-146 IF is going to be out of luck with most existing transverters. Most antennas, feeds and PAs would probably have acceptable (or at least usable) performance at 1298-1300MHz.

Even if the US does not make any changes to 23cm allocations, changes in EU frequency allocations will still affect US operation because to follow the activity we will need to operate on the same frequencies as the EU stations.
