Many stories have emerged. Such as one of my sisters having to walk from the Christchurch CBD to Sumner as her car was located in a damaged car parking building, plus various roads were unusable. She did manage to get a ride some of the way but had to walk most of the way. She had her two young girls in school and was worried about them. They were in fact safe at the school until she arrived. Her husband was in Auckland at the time. He travelled to Blenheim where he hired a car and drove to Christchurch to get home. They have since left for Queenstown, as they still have no water, power or sewerage at their house. It is unknown when they will return to Christchurch.

Field Day has come and gone, and I hope those attending had a good time.

The Big Coast 2010 will be held without our assistance this year, so fingers crossed nothing happens without us being present, and that we may in the future be involved again.
