The following from John ZL2TWS:

The following item was published by Jerry Wanger KK6LFS who is the importer and distributor of the CSI systems DMR radios. Refers to radios imported to USA in \$US.

Most of the AREC DMR network users are operating CSI or other Chinese manufactured radios.

The group promoting the DMR network claimed from the beginning that they wanted a DV system that was more affordable with radio choices not available with D-Star and Yaesu fusion.

D-Star currently has many manufacture options but only two major manufacturers being ICOM and Kenwood.

Yaesu Fusion has one manufacturer.

The message below is "you get what you pay for"

Personal experience with two cheap Chinese DMR radios is that the quality and longevity of the hardware is not expected compared to a D-Star or Fusion radio.

Read below and make you own mind up before purchasing a Chinese radio.

QUOTE:

We think different than the Chinese when it comes to customer service. They often allocate a 2 to 3 percent of the sales price as money to be used for repairs. That means if you buy 100 radios to sell, they will only honour the warranty for the first three customers. After that those customers are out of luck. See how that attitude goes in this Country.

For those companies that want to resell Chinese Products, you have to buy extra products just so you can service your customers in case there are any issues or you can have the technical expertise to fix these products. They will supply you parts to fix the radio. However as a reseller, plan on spending a few thousand dollars on the top of the line de-soldering and soldering equipment with a microscope so you can see the parts, Then also plan on spending about \$38,000 for a service monitor to actually test the radios.

As an individual, they will sell you radios direct but they will not service the radios or give you any technical help unless you can speak Mandarin Chinese.

Some of you have bought the products from Hong Kong distributors and that is a big mistake. While they can ship a radio here for about \$12, it would cost you between \$70-\$120 to ship it back to have it repaired even if they agree to fix it. If you ship lots of radios back at the same time, it will cost about \$10 to China and about \$5 to get it back. Lots means shipping at least 100 radios, and possible much more. Then when it gets there we have found they normally take months to repair and get it returned. For all practical purposes you might as well junk the radios or repair them yourself.
