### **D-Star SDR transceiver "DummyRepeater" for loan.**

Branch 63 has a complete D-Star SDR transceiver for loan to members. Comes complete with everything you need to get on D-Star via the internet. Connects to Mt Climie D-Star repeaters, gateways and hotspots around the world.

The package includes headphones, microphone, HDMI cable, Ethernet cable, Raspberry Pi3, DV3000 dongle and power supply.

What you need to have ready is the following:

- 1) TV or computer monitor with HDMI input.
- 2) Internet router Ethernet port for connection to supplied Ethernet cable.
- 3) 230VAC outlet for the supplied plug pack.

Your call sign must be entered into the transceiver before using and D-Star registration confirmed via Mark ZL2UFI.
