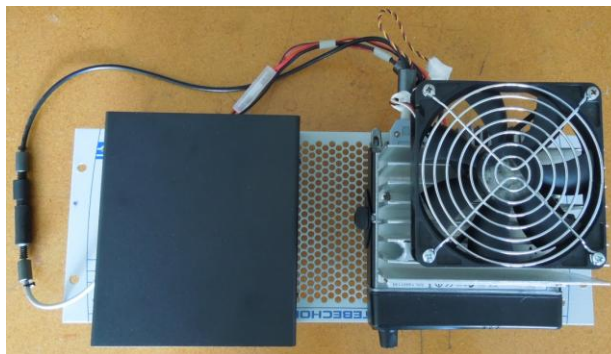
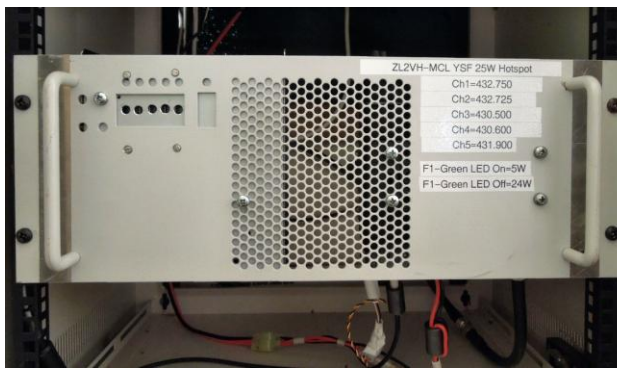
ZL2VH-MCL On Air from ZL2VH Clubrooms

On Saturday 25th November, a Yaesu System Fusion (YSF) Hotspot was installed at the ZL2VH clubrooms by ZL2NSA, ZL2DRM and ZL2TWS.

The YSF Hotspot consists of:

- 1) Tait TM8110 UHF Simplex Radio supplied by Brian ZL1HN.
- 2) Odroid XU4 VK4TUX PC Image.
- 3) G4KLX MMDVM Modem build by VK4TUX.

Following pictures are of the YSF Hotspot build on a 19 inch rack panel. Currently on Channel 3 = 430.500 MHz running 24-25 Watts.
