Electrochemical signals from plants can drive robots

Some people dream of a smart home with gadgets that can interact with you. But can you imagine a plant being a part of your smart home interactions?

A professor has been working on harnessing plants to work with technology. Harpreet Sareen, of MIT's Media Lab, wants to harness the natural intelligence of trees, grass, herbs and other plants. He initially focused on one-way interactions using the plants' electromechanical signals.

A plant-robot hybrid could navigate toward patches of light in response to light shining on its leaves. Click here to see the video. Furthermore, he wants to make this bi-directional, so that machines are not just responding to plants but getting plants to respond to machines too.

His second creation turns plants into motion sensors, by implanting conductive wires in stems and leaves. This is still early in the research phase, but cyborg botany will be something that changes how plants function in a few years' time.
