## **President's Report**

### Wellington Beacons update. (From John ZL2TWS)

Hawkins Hill VHF/UHF/SHF Beacons may not be on air until 2022. Under ground conduit that passes coax cables between the beacon TX building and antenna pole has been blocked. Cables will not move and cannot be used to draw through new cables. A winch is required to pull through old cables attached to a new draw rope.

Weather, mainly high winds, has prevented outside work. Once equinox winds have eased the WVHFG hopes to be able to continue work.

Pole ladder was delivered to site two weeks ago.

National system is still not working south due to pine forest blockage at Belmont and new DMR repeaters including 710 Belmont are a higher priority than the beacons. 710 gain north/south arrays still need to be connected. 20dB of de-sense is currently measured on 710 so not that usable.

We wish WVHFG the best conditions and resources to get Hawkins Hill back to historical service. It is one of the best sites in Wellington like Climie.

Bay of Islands 6m Beacon on 50.011 MHz is back on air.

Call Sign ZL1SIX located at Manginangina RF64VT.

25W, Vertical, 3el Yagi Beaming West, CW modulation.

The ZL1SIX beacon was spotted yesterday 26th Nov in VK2 and VK5.

ZL2VH 28.229 MHz beacon was also spotted in VK5 the same day.

#### ILLW (Lighthouse weekend)



## Mag Loop Capacitor Starter Kit



This is a very easy to build variable capacitor with widely spaced plates. The configuration is a butterfly design, so that there are no sliding contacts to either side of the capacitor electrodes.

The capacitor stator plates are suspended on four M6 brass threaded rods. This makes direct connection to the ends of a robust loop conductor very practical. This very direct connection will keep the mag loop resistive losses to a minimum which is very important if building a transmitting loop.

The value of the capacitor in pico Farads (pF) can be adapted to a wide range of mag loop arrangements by adding or removing stator and rotor plates that are held on the threaded rods with M6 brass nuts. The starter kit with 9 rotor plates and 20 stator plates will give a capacitance of about 12pF to 65pF and a voltage rating of 3.5kV.
